#### The Reflection (required)

<u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- This week's Point is based on our core value of "Discipleicity". Take a few minutes and explain/discuss/review our c3 discipleship process.
- Read John 13:3-17. When Jesus said, "I have set you an example...", what was he talking about? Washing feet, or something more...?
- The word "disciple" literally means one who follows the pattern of their teacher. If we are disciples of Jesus, or Christ-followers, then we need to <u>do</u> what Jesus did. Discuss the following traits of Jesus then brainstorm <u>more</u> examples of where he demonstrates each in the Bible:
  - <u>Trusted</u> In Uncertainty: Matthew 26:38-39
  - <u>Selflessness</u> Amid Adversity: Luke 23:33-34
  - <u>Spoke Out</u> Despite Unpopularity: Matthew 23:13
  - <u>Acted</u> During Apathy: Matthew 8:1-3
- Read these other verses related to each of these traits and discuss how it ties in. Then choose the <u>one</u> that you need to work on when it comes to <u>living like Jesus</u>, and share it with your group:
  - <u>Trusted</u> In Uncertainty: Hebrews 11:6
  - <u>Selflessness</u> Amid Adversity: Philippians 2:3-5
  - <u>Spoke Out</u> Despite Unpopularity: 1 Peter 3:15
  - <u>Acted</u> During Apathy: James 2:14-17
- Break up into groups for each trait and close by praying for each other

#### The References

Main Passage: John 13:3-17 (NIV)<sup>\*selected verses, read full passage in Bible</sup> ...After that, he poured water into a basin and <u>began to wash his disciples' feet</u>, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him... ...Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also <u>should wash one another's feet</u>. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you...

## Hebrews 11:6 (NIV)

And <u>without faith it is impossible to please God</u>, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

## Philippians 2:3-5 (NLT)

<u>Don't be selfish</u>; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too. <u>You must have the same attitude that</u> <u>Christ Jesus had</u>.

### <u>1 Peter 3:15 (NIV)</u>

But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always <u>be prepared to give an</u> <u>answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that</u> <u>you have</u>. But do this with gentleness and respect,

#### James 2:14-17 (NIV)

What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to them, "Go in peace; keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? In the same way, <u>faith by itself</u>, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.
