The Reflection (required) <u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- Since this series builds on the life of Nehemiah, take a moment to review the story so far, from the beginning of the book of Nehemiah.
- In the Point, we looked at 4 kinds of opposition that Nehemiah faced. Without taking too much time on this, briefly review how he responded to each: Verbal Attack; Physical Attack; Internal Attack; Social Attack.
- Thinking about all that Nehemiah has been through so far, how do you think you would have responded to the opposition if you were him?
- When we face opposition, the temptation to give up is not usually because we change what we believe, but because <u>it's so hard</u> to stand strong. Read & <u>discuss what these verses say about facing opposition</u>:
 - Examine It: 1 Peter 4:14-16
 - Expect It: John 15:18-20a; 1 Peter 4:12-13; Mark 14:33-36
 - Take a moment to describe what Jesus was feeling in Mark 14.
 - It's Worth It!: 1 Corinthians 15:58; Galatians 6:9; James 1:12
 - God's Got It: 2 Corinthians 4:7-9
- Every time Nehemiah faced opposition, he went to God in prayer about it. As a Pr'me we are in this together and are here for one another, so we're going to close our time praying for each other: What opposition are you facing in your life right now? How can we pray for you? [When each person finishes sharing, ask for a volunteer (no pressure) to pray for them right then and there.]

Main Passage: Nehemiah 4:1-6:14 (NIV)

...4:8They all plotted together to come and fight against Jerusalem and stir up trouble against it. 9But we prayed to our God and posted a guard day and night to meet this threat...
