The Repeats (required)

The Reflection (required)

<u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- **Before we get further into the discussion, as a Pr'me we're going to work on memorizing Psalm 119:<u>7</u>-11 this week. [read verse]**
- Have 5 people read the following passages from 1 Kings 12:
 - v. 1-5; v. 6-7; v. 8-11; v. 12-15; v. 16-18
- In Rehoboam's failure, what was the problem with where he got his advice (v. 8)? Do you think this was simply about age? Why or why not?
- Read Proverbs 13:20. In what ways have you seen your friends affect your choices (good or bad) [even as an adult!]?
- Read Proverbs 1:10-19. Solomon explains that, realize it or not, our friends flavor & influence our view of right & wrong. How have you seen this <u>subtle</u> influence at work in the world around you?
- Read 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1. What is Paul clearly saying in this passage? How does this mesh with reaching those who don't yet follow Christ—are we <u>not</u> to be friends??? What is the issue here?
- The Bible has a lot to say about our main "influencer" friends. Be honest, what excuses have <u>you</u> made about the wrong friends in your life?
- Is there a friendship that is drawing you away from Jesus, that you need to filter out? This is never easy, but it's <u>so important</u>. Partner those who share, with others to pray for each other throughout this week.

Main Passage: 1 Kings 12:1-20 (NLT)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

...But Rehoboam rejected the advice of the older men and instead asked the opinion of the young men who had grown up with him and were now his advisers...

Proverbs 13:20 (NIV)

Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm.

Proverbs 1:10-19 (NIV)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

My son, if sinful men entice you, do not give in to them. If they say, "Come along with us; let's lie in wait for innocent blood, let's ambush some harmless soul; let's swallow them alive, like the grave, and whole, like those who go down to the pit; we will get all sorts of valuable things and fill our houses with plunder; cast lots with us; we will all share the loot"...
