

Cropped: God's Here When There are at Least Two of Us! *Completed:* Jesus Reinforces Restoration

The Repeats (required)

Yes, they are the same, but WE change, so <u>please</u> <u>discuss</u> these with your group

The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- Read John 1:1-3, Psalm 139:7-12, and Matthew 28:20b. With those passages in mind, read Matthew 18:20. Why do you think Christ-followers tend to know the *cropped* version of this passage?
- Read Matthew 18:15-20. How does v. 20 fit into the overall context of this passage? (see v. 16 for a hint) Why do you think Jesus reminds about His presence when talking about restoration?
- Let's get personal about the "Rules of Restoration" from the Point:
 - Who to Confront: Christ-followers (Read 1 Corinthians 5:9-13)
 - How has the church messed up on this one over the years?
 - What to Confront: Sin (Read Galatians 6:1)
 - What are some wrong reasons for confronting others?
 - Where to Confront: Privately (Read Matthew 5:23-24)
 - How can our pride get in the way of confronting privately?
 - When to Confront: ASAP (Read Hebrews 3:12-13)
 - Do you tend to flee from confrontation? Why is this unhealthy?
 - Why to Confront: To Restore (Read James 5:19-20)
 - Why is understanding this so VERY important to confrontation?
 - How to Confront: As a Process (Read Matthew 18:15-17)
 - List the 4 steps of restoration. What happens if we skip a step?
- Without details, which describes you right now: God is calling me to restore someone OR God is calling me to respond to my own sin? Pray.

Main Passage: <u>Matthew 18:15-20 (NIV)</u>^{*selected verses, read full passage in Bible} If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault...<u>For where two</u> <u>or three gather in my name, there am I with them</u>.

John 1:1-3 (NIV)^{*selected verses, read full passage in Bible} In the beginning was the Word...He was with God in the beginning...

<u>Psalm 139:7-12 (NIV)</u>^{*selected verses, read full passage in Bible Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?</u>}

<u>Matthew 28:20b (NLT)</u> And <u>be sure of this: I am with you always</u>, even to the end of the age.

<u>1 Corinthians 5:9-13 (NLT)</u>^{*selected verses, read full passage in Bible}<u>It isn't my responsibility to judge outsiders, but it certainly is your re-</u>sponsibility to judge those inside the church who are sinning...

<u>Galatians 6:1 (NIV)</u>^{*selected verses, read full passage in Bible} Brothers and sisters, <u>if someone is caught in a sin</u>, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently...

<u>Matthew 5:23-24 (NIV)</u>^{*selected verses, read full passage in Bible} ...First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift...

<u>Hebrews 3:12-13 (NLT)</u>^{*selected verses, read full passage in Bible} ...You must <u>warn each other every day, while it is still "today</u>,"...

James 5:19-20 (NIV)^{*selected verses, read full passage in Bible} ...Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins.
