The Point:

Weedy Dirt: Don't Be Distracted, This World Isn't the Goal

Discussion Generators

- → God is ALWAYS working! Sometimes we just need to keep our "antennae up", to be looking for it. Go around your group and share your God Moments of how you have seen God working, either in your life or in the life of another, over the past week.
- •What has stood out to you so far from the Dirt Point series?

- → Read Mark 4:3-8, 14-20. Reviewing the Point, what was the problem with the seeds planted in weedy dirt (v. 7)?
- →What did the weeds represent (v. 18-19)?
- → Jesus explains that sometimes the message gets choked out because people hear the message, but focus on the wrong goal—the world.
- → Read 1 Corinthians 3:18-20. What are some ways that "the world" has affected our thinking as Christ-followers?

- •How does Romans 12:2 tie together the concept of "changing our thinking" with last week's idea of "growing deep roots"?
- → Read 2 Corinthians 10:3-5. What are some ways that "the world" has affected our fighting as Christ-followers?
- → Read 1 John 2:15-17. What are some ways that "the world" has <u>affected our focus</u> as Christ-followers?
- •Read James 4:4. These are STRONG words about what happens if we love the world. Why do you think James says this so intensely?
- •If time permits, as a group summarize the following from "Tending the Soil of the Story"* in the Point on Sunday:
 - Give Them Perspective (1 Timothy 6:7)
 - Give Them Space (Luke 9:23-25)
 - Give Them to God (1 Corinthians 3:8)
- →Last week we shared and prayed for distractions that are hindering our growth with Jesus. This week we are going to share specifically about "weeds" (which are bad distractions) the keep us from making a difference for Jesus. Share ONE way that EACH of the following has choked you. How have you been choked by:
 - ...Keeping Up? (Mark 4:19a)
 - ...Getting More? (Mark 4:19b)
 - ...Wanting the World? (Mark 4:19c)

Bible Verses

Mark 4:3-8, 14-20 (NIV)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and <u>choked the plants, so</u> that they did not bear grain...

...Still others, like seed sown among thorns, hear the word; but the worries of this life, the deceitfulness of wealth and the desires for other things come in and choke the word, making it unfruitful.

1 John 2:15-17 (NLT)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible
