- Imagine: what do you think it was like to be a part of the church in Acts 12? Based on what you know of the early church, do you think Acts 12:5 was “normal” for them? Why or why not?
- Read Acts 2:42-47. What parts of the underlined passages (on “The References” section) are the most meaningful or exciting to you?
- Read the following “Togethers” & verses. Then, go around your group and share which is the hardest for you. Share why you think it’s hard.
  - Accept Together (Romans 15:7)
  - Teach Together (Colossians 3:16)
  - Respect Together (Philippians 2:3)
  - Serve Together (1 Peter 4:10)
  - Hurt Together (Galatians 6:2)
  - Forgive Together (Colossians 3:13)
  - Encourage Together (1 Thessalonians 5:11)
  - Love Together! (John 13:34-35)
- Close your time in prayer for one another to be together IN community.

Acts 12:1-17 (NIV)\*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

...After arresting [Peter], [Herod] put him in prison, handing him over to be guarded by four squads of four soldiers each. Herod intended to bring him out for public trial after the Passover. So Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God for him....
