THE POINT:

The Repeats (required)

The Reflection (required) <u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- How would you describe Biblical c2:Congregation to someone else?
- Read Acts 16:22-25. If you were in Paul & Silas' situation, how would you have responded? What concerns would you have? Be honest.
- When you think of the word "worship" what comes to mind?
- Music is a <u>type</u> of worship. Read Psalm 150 and list the different ways music was used in worship.
- In the Point, we learned that worship also goes way beyond music. Read the following verses, then share which one is the most surprising...or unusual...or challenging to your understanding of worship.
 - Singing (Ephesians 5:18b-19)
 - Learning (Psalm 1:1-2)
 - Thanksgiving (Hebrews 12:28-29)
 - Giving (Philippians 4:15-18)
 - Serving (Hebrews 13:15-16)
 - Living! (Romans 12:1)
- Worship should be a natural part of <u>everything</u> that we do. Reflect on your life and <u>share one way/area that you need to practice worship-ping beyond Sunday mornings</u>, so that your group can pray for you this week. Close your time by praying for these areas for each person.

The References

Acts 16:22-25 (NLT)

A mob quickly formed against Paul and Silas, and the city officials ordered them stripped and beaten with wooden rods. They were severely beaten, and then they were thrown into prison. The jailer was ordered to make sure they didn't escape. So the jailer put them into the inner dungeon and clamped their feet in the stocks.

<u>Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God</u>, and the other prisoners were listening.
