# The Reflection (required) <u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- How would you describe Biblical c3: Caring to someone else?
- Read Acts 4:32-35. How would you summarize that passage in ONLY one word? Have everyone share.
- What about this passage is amazing or exciting to you, and why?
- In the Point this week, we were challenged by some mindset changes when it comes to c3:Caring/giving. Read the following verses, then give an example of what each would look like, either from personal experience, or just an invented story:
  - Do for One...what you can't do for all (Luke 15:8-10)
  - Do What YOU Can...because you can't do it all(1 Cor 12:14-27)
  - Do What is Right...which may not seem "nice" (1 John 3:16-18)
  - Do What is Hard...because of the Goal (Philippians 2:17)
- Now that we have an idea of what each of these mindset changes should look like, go around your group an <u>share which one is the</u> <u>hardest for you and why</u>? What can your Pr'me do to help you in this area: assisting...encouraging...praying...butt-kicking...etc.?
- As you consider your group's c3Opportunity for 5th Sunday | October, does it fit within one or more of these giving mindset changes? Close your time by praying for your groups c3Opportunity.
