The Reflection (required)

- Read Matthew 6:19-25. This passage makes six comparisons between things that matter and things that don't? Using the following verses as a guide, discuss what matters in each comparison & why:
 - •19@20; 21a@21b; 22@23; 24a@24a; 24b@24b; 25a@25b
- Why is it so easy to lose our perspective when it comes to money?
- Often we can tell if our perspective is in the right place by the things we say. Read each of the following and <u>discuss practical ways that</u> we could build a "fence" to protect us from that fouled-up focus:
 - "Once I have enough..."
 - -Your Goal is Your Security: Luke 12:15-21
 - "Here's what I need to do..."
 - Your Plan is Your Priority: Luke 12:29-34
 - "I need a bigger/newer/nicer..."
 - You're Discontent w/ Your Provision: 1 Timothy 6:6-10
 - "What have you done?!?!"
 - Your Possessions Replace Your People: James 5:1-6
 - "I can't afford that right now..."
 - Your Giving is Based on Your Budget: 2 Corinthians 8:1-3
- Have you heard yourself say one these phases recently? Read 1
 Timothy 6:10 again. Is it time to take a hard look at your own fouled
 -up focus and make changes? Be vulnerable and share with your
 group: what "fence" is God asking you to build? Pray for each other.

Main Passage: Matthew 6:19-25 (NLT)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be...

Luke 12:15-21 (NLT)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

1 Timothy 6:6-10 (NIV)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with that...Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

James 5:1-6 (NLT)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

...Listen! Hear the cries of the field workers whom you have cheated of their pay...You have spent your years on earth in luxury, satisfying your every desire. You have fattened yourselves for the day of slaughter. You have condemned and killed innocent people, who do not resist you.

2 Corinthians 8:1-3 (NLT)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible
