Daniel 6

Discussion Generators

- .What are two things that stood out to you from this week's Point? (they can be silly, serious, stupid, or spiritual)
- If you an eight year old were to ask you what Sunday's point was about, how would you paraphrase it for them?
- •Read Daniel 6:4. Has anyone here ever been thrown into a lion's den? Okay maybe not literally, but have you ever felt like you were and what were the circumstances that helped create that feeling for you? Can someone share a time that either you or someone you know was singled out for doing the right thing and mocked or mistreated for doing so?
- .Read Romans 8:31-39. First, what is Paul saying about how God showed us that He loves us? Why is that important to remember? Do you think it is hard to really grasp what God's love for us is really like? Why or why not?
- .Read John 15:18. Jesus is teaching He warns that there would be a good chance that anyone who follows Him would be hated. Why do you think He would share such an unappealing insight with us and prospective followers?

Discussion Generators

- On a scale of 1 to 10, with 1 being easy and 10 being extremely difficult, how hard would you say it is to be of follower of Christ and to do the right things, and why?
- Daniel's life is an amazing example to us of understanding God's love for us and responding in obedience. Daniel lived prior to Jesus as well so he didn't even have knowledge that we have in what life in Christ can be. So let's go back to paraphrase this week for an eight year old. What would we tell an eight that they should do with what we learned from the point and our discussion tonight?
