Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- •As we consider the third "neighbor" in our series, take a few minutes to read & explain each of these, then answer the questions:
 - Pretenders Have Authority to Do Something Luke 10:31a & 32a
 - Titles give authority, but what other types of authority are there?
 - Pretenders Are Aware of The Problem Luke 10:31b & 32b
 - Why is this a key part of being a Pretender? [seeing, yet ignore]
 - Pretenders Will Avoid when No One Knows Luke 10:31c & 32c
 - What do you think would happen if someone saw or found out?
- Have you met Pretenders in your life? Without names, describe them.
- When have you been a Pretender? Share your story.
- To stop pretending, we need to be honest with *ourselves*. Read and answer these and then <u>share examples</u> of what each looks like today *Who Are You/What Do You Do...*
 - ...when Everyone's Looking? Matthew 23:25-28
 - According to Jesus, what was the goal of the Pharisees?
 - ...when "The Usual" Are Looking? Titus 2:7-8
 - Who are "The Usual"? Why is this so important (good or bad)?
 - ...when No One's Looking? 1 Peter 3:15-16; Mark 7:14-23
 - What is Jesus MOST concerned about with His followers?
- Can you be honest...which of these is your biggest struggle? Why?
- Each week, we're going to ask the question: "Which Neighbor Are You?". So far we've looked at *The Excuser, The Broken*, and now *The Pretenders.* Which one (or parts of each) is most where you are <u>right now</u>? How can we pray for you?

Main Passage: Luke 10:25-32 (NIV)

...In reply Jesus said: "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he was attacked by robbers. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead. A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. So too, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side...."

Matthew 23:25-28 (NIV)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

... "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of the bones of the dead and everything unclean. In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness."

Titus 2:7-8 (NIV)

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In everything set them an example by doing what is good. In your teaching show integrity, seriousness and soundness of speech that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have nothing bad to say about us.

1 Peter 2:15-16 (NIV)

But <u>in your hearts revere Christ as Lord</u>. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, <u>keeping a clear conscience</u>, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.

Mark 7:1-23 (NLT)*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

...And then he added, "It is what comes from inside that defiles you. For from within, out of a person's heart, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, greed, wickedness, deceit, lustful desires, envy, slander, pride, and foolishness. All these vile things come from within; they are what defile you."
