#### The Repeats (required)

#### The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- Before we look at this week's passage, discuss these two questions:
  - What "weight" is given to someone's last words before death?
  - Why do you repeat a statement to someone?
- Read John 17:20-23. In this <u>final prayer</u>, what does Jesus 2x pray *for* us (v. 21a & 22-23a)? What does he 2x pray as the *response* (v.21b & 23b)? <u>How</u> does our unity (same team!) draw people to Jesus?
- This series has been all about what it looks like for *Brothers And Sisters* to be on the same team. <u>Take time to review and discuss</u>. *We*:
  - Have each Other's Backs ("Flash! Thunder!") 1 Cor.1:10-13
    - •How did Paul get his brother's backs? How can we do this?
  - Help Each Other Out (If/Then) Philippians 2:1-5
    - Why do we need to be in each other's lives?
  - Give Each Other Stuff (mc3Missions) Acts 4:32-35
    - What was the mindset of the church? What was the result?
  - Push Each Other On (Leeches vs. Remoras) Ephesians 4:1-16
    - What happens to the church when we fail to serve?
  - Worship At Each Other's Side (Blind Spots) Romans 15:5-7
    - How can disunity be a blind spot in our worship?
  - Pick Each Other Up (c3 Softball) Galatians 6:1-5
    - How are we to respond when someone slips into sin?
  - Forgive Each Other's Flaws (Sentimental Objects) Col. 3:13-15
    - How can failure to forgive hurt the whole church?
- Go around your group and share: what area from this list God is leading YOU to work on, so that people can see Jesus in our unity?

#### Main Passage: John 17: 20-23 (NLT)

"I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through their message. I pray that they will all be ONE, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me. I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me."

...No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had...

# Ephesians 4:1-16 (NLT)\*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

...<u>As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts</u> grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love.

# Romans 15:5-7 (NLT)\*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

...accept each other just as Christ has accepted you so that God will be given glory.

# Galatians 6:1-5 (NET)\*selected verses, read full passage in Bible

Brothers and sisters, if a person is discovered in some sin, you who are spiritual restore such a person in a spirit of gentleness...
