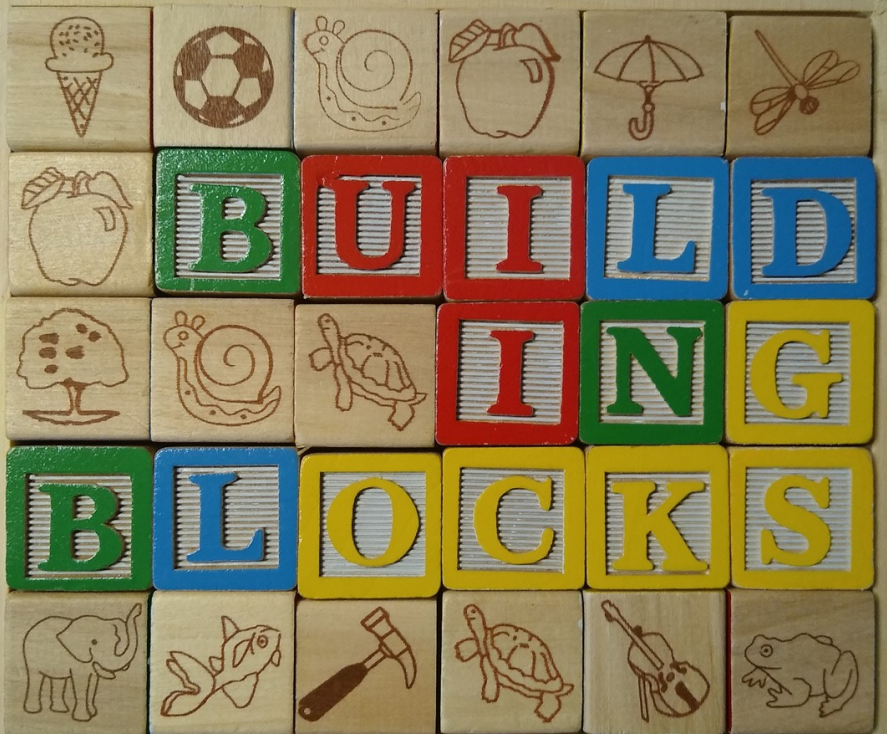

The Repeats (required)

They are the same, but *WE* change, so please discuss these with your group

- At mc3, God Moments are a chance for us to *be intentional* about noticing what God is doing in our lives—try to use your week to notice these moments to share in Pr'me. Go around your group and share your God Moments: how have you seen God working, either in your life or in the life of another over the past week?
- Is there anything that you want to share that has stood out to you so far from the current Point series?

The Review (optional)

Use this section only if you want to review for those who were not in the Point

- Have someone explain the Point in their own words.*
- What object lesson or illustration was used to communicate the Point this week? How did this apply to the Point?*
- Have someone summarize the main Bible passage/story from the Point: **Ecclesiastes 4:7-12**.*
- How did this Bible passage teach the Point?*

The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- What is the most difficult physical challenge that you've had to do?
- In **Ecclesiastes 4:7-12** Solomon reflects on the problems of doing life alone. Read these verses and discuss why *We Need Each Other*.
 - **For Purpose (7-8)** What is the tragedy that Solomon sees here?
 - **For Accomplishment (9)** Share examples where 2 is better than 1.
 - **For Restoration (10)** What are ways can we "pick each other up"?
 - **For Caring (11)** Share a time where someone c³ared for you.
 - **For Protection (12)** Why is it so important as Christ-Followers that we have each other's backs? Who is the real enemy?
- Each week of this series is *piece* of what it takes to grow to be more like Jesus. Here's how we can do that this week:
 - **It Requires Uncomfortability.** Read **Hebrews 10:24-25**.
 - How can connecting with each other be uncomfortable? According to this passage, why are we *not* to give up?
 - **It Requires Humility.** Read **Romans 12:3-5**.
 - What leads us to think *I don't need them? Or they don't need me?* In what ways is humility is required for connecting with each other?
 - **It Requires Energy.** Read **Proverbs 27:17; Galatians 6:1-3**.
 - How has a "me-first" mindset affected perspectives on church in America? What do these passages expect from us?
 - **It Requires Vulnerability.** Read **Galatians 1:10**.
 - Why do you think people find it hard to be vulnerable? What are the advantages of being vulnerable with each other?
 - **It Requires Unity.** Read **John 13:34-35; 1 Corinthians 1:10**.
 - What does unity mean? How are we to *love* each other? What does that look like? Why is unity such a big deal?
- Which of these 5 "requirements" is the hardest for you? Why?
- As we grow individually, mc³ grows together! Close by choosing a way to pray for each other to connect with Christ-Followers regularly.
