Go around your group and share your God Moments: how have you seen God working, either in your life or in the life of another over the past week?

- •Have someone explain the Point in their own words.\*
- •What object lesson or illustration was used to communicate the Point this week? How did this apply to the Point?\*
- •Have someone summarize the main Bible passage/story from the Point: John 13:1-17.\*
- How did this Bible passage teach the Point?\*

## **The Reflection** (required) <u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- Growing up, who was someone that you wanted to imitate?
- •In John 13:1-17, Jesus <u>shows</u> us what ministry is. Read and discuss these verses about Jesus' example that we are to imitate:
  - •*Ministry Is Love* (1) What is so powerful about the last line of this verse? What did Jesus do "now"?
  - •*Ministry Is Humility* (2-5) What did Jesus "know"? How does this make the "so" (v.4) all about humility? (Read Philippians 2:5-8)
  - Ministry Is Response (6-11) Looking through the metaphor here, how is ministry (v.10a) a response to being rescued by Jesus (v.8b)?
    Ministry Is Obedience (12-17) Describe the different ways that Jesus says the same thing here? What is the result of obeying (v.17)?
- •Each week of this series is *piece* of what it takes to grow to be more like Jesus. Here's <u>how</u> we can do that this week:
  - •By Using Your Gifts. Read Romans 12:3-8; 1 Peter 4:10-11.
    - *Who* has given us our gifts? *Why* have we been given gifts? With that in mind, what is wrong with <u>not</u> serving in ministry?
  - By <u>Understanding</u> Growth. Read Ephesians 4:11-16; Colossians 1:10.
    According to these passages, how do we grow? Why does this seem like a paradox, especially in our "self-care" culture [in other words, serving *outwardly* leads to growth *inwardly*]?

•By <u>Committing</u> to Go On. Read Luke 9:59-62.

- •How does Jesus feel about commitment? How has "but first..." crept into excuses for the way that <u>you</u> serve in ministry?
- By <u>Refusing</u> to Give Up. Read 1 Corinthians 15:58; Galatians 6:9-10.
  List the different ways that these passages say "don't give up". What are the benefits of not quitting? Was there a time in your life where you have seen God "reap a harvest" *through* you?
  Which of these 4 is the *hardest* for you? Which is *most encouraging*?
- •As we grow individually, mc3 grows together! Close by choosing a way to pray for each other to serve God in ministry.
