## The Repeats (required)

They are the same, but *WE* change, so <u>please</u> <u>discuss</u> these with your group

- At mc3, God Moments are a chance for us to *be intentional* about noticing what God is doing in our lives—try to <u>use your week</u> to notice these moments to share in Pr'me. Go around your group and share your God Moments: how have you seen God working, either in your life or in the life of another over the past week?
- Is there anything that you want to share that has stood out to you so far from the current Point series?

## The Review (optional)

- Have someone explain the Point in their own words.\*
- •What object lesson or illustration was used to communicate the Point this week? How did this apply to the Point?\*
- Have someone summarize the main Bible passage/story from the Point: John 4:1-30, 39-42.\*
- How did this Bible passage teach the Point?\*

## **The Reflection** (required) <u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- •What is your favorite "recreational distraction"; what do you like to do to get your mind off of things?
- •Read John 4:1-26 and discuss the ways that Jesus shares...*Himself*. <u>Then give examples of how each can look for us today</u>.
  - *Take Risks* (1-6) Why was it significant that Jesus "had" to do this?
  - •*Be Kind* (7-9) How did Jesus show kindness here?
  - •*Meet Needs* (10-15) What was the woman's "felt need"?
  - •Address Pain (16-18) What was the woman's "real need"?
- Avoid Diversions (19-24) How did she create a diversion? Why?
  Share Jesus (25-26) What if Jesus ended the conversation before v.26?
  In John 4:28-30, the woman then tells others about Jesus. How does she do this? What is their response (Read John 4:39-42)?
- •Each week of this series is *piece* of what it takes to grow to be more
  - like Jesus. Here's <u>how</u> we can do that, by *Avoiding the Diversions*:
    - Don't Hate the World. Instead, <u>See</u> Like Jesus. Matt. 9:36
      Sometimes the world is frustrating, but how can this become a
      - diversion to sharing Jesus? How did Jesus see the crowds?
    - Don't Have the Answers. Instead, <u>Share</u> Your Story. John 9:1-34
      Have you avoided sharing Jesus b/c you don't "have all the answers"? What was the blind man's repeated reply to questions?
    - Don't Solve the Problems. Instead, Invite to Experience. Jn.1:45-49
    - •Have you felt the need to "defend" Jesus? Has this kept you from sharing? How did Philip respond to Nathaniel's complaint?
    - Don't Hide Your Faith. Instead, <u>Shine</u> Your Light. Matt. 5:14-16
      Have you ever wanted to hide your faith from others? Why? How do we shine our light? Why does this matter?
    - Don't "Prove Your Point". Instead, Love on Purpose. 1 Cor.13:1-8
      What do we mean that "proving our point" can get in the way of sharing Jesus? Why is love such a powerful way to share Jesus?
- •Which of these are the <u>top two</u> biggest diversions for you?
- Close by praying for you to tell others about Jesus passionately.
