



## The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

• Do you have a funny wedding story?

- In Acts 9:1-22, we read how God transformed Saul from a persecutor of the church, to Paul a missionary *for* the church. When we talk about persecuting the church, what did that look like in Paul's time?
  While we probably haven't killed or imprisoned anyone for being a part of the church, we have "persecuted" the church in other ways. Discuss these ways *We Tear Down Jesus' Church*:
  - *by What We Think* Read Matthew 16:18; Ephesians 5:26-27
    <u>Whose</u> church is it? Why is understanding this so important?
    How would you feel if someone insulted your bride/spouse?
  - *by What We Do* Read Matthew 5:14-16; Philippians 2:15b
    Who is watching? How can our actions tear down Jesus' church?
  - *by What We Say* Read Ephesians 4:29-30; 1 Thessalonians 5:11
    List the ways that we use our words to persecute Jesus' church.
  - *by When We Connect* Read Hebrews 10:25
    How can you tell if someone thinks that something is important?
    How does our "attendance" show how we feel about His church?

• Which of the above "persecutions" is *your* biggest struggle, & why?

- •Despite Saul persecuting His church, God still used him! <u>Have your</u> <u>group explain</u> these passages of what God did though Paul:
  - God Used Him to Spread the Church Read Acts 8:1-3; 13:1-3
  - God Used Him to Separate the Church Read Acts 15:1-2,19
  - God Used Him to Sharpen the Church Read Rom. 1:1; Philemon 1:1
