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Your Voice is Required to Duplicate Your Courage is Needed to Duplicate

The Repeats (required)

They are the same, but *WE* change, so please discuss these with your group

- [Share the announcements (on FB thread) with your group]
- ***Remember: this cycle, we're combining prayer requests with God Moments.*** God Moments are when we celebrate God doing big things in our lives...and we want to pray for God to do big things in our lives as well! When God answers these prayers, they become God moments! Go around your group and share your prayer needs or God Moments. [Leaders: pray for these as best fits your Pr'me]
- Is there anything that you want to share that has stood out to you so far from the current Point series?

Use this section only if you want to review for those who were not in the Point

- Have someone explain the past two Points in their own words.*
- What object lesson or illustration was used to communicate the Point these two weeks? How did they apply to the Point?*
- Have someone summarize (but not necessarily read) the main Bible passages/stories from these Points: **1 Pet. 3:15-17; Rom. 1:16-17.***
- How did these Bible passages teach each Point?*

DOUBLE UP Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- What is your favorite courtroom TV show or movie (reality or fiction)?
- To *Duplicate* ourselves, Peter gives us some direction on how:
 - **Exalt Jesus** Read 1 Peter 3:15a
 - What does it mean to set apart Christ as Lord in your heart?
 - Why is this the foundation for the rest of what Peter shares?
 - **Exude Hope** Read 1 Peter 3:15b
 - How do we “exude hope”? How does our example (wk. 2) tie in?
 - **Expect Questions** Read 1 Peter 3:15c
 - What are we to be ready to answer? “Whose” hope?
 - **Explain Gently** Read 1 Peter 3:15d-16a
 - What does “explain gently” look like? Why does this matter?
- Use the Rom. 6:23 cards to walk thru a 1-verse gospel explanation.
- Have you made/eaten something that was missing a key ingredient?
- Paul tells the Roman church why he is bold about sharing the gospel:
 - **Perseverance** Read Romans 1:16a
 - What did Paul decide? What is “the gospel/good news”?
 - **Power** Read Romans 1:16b
 - Do you think the power of God encourages boldness? Why/not?
 - **Purpose** Read Romans 1:16c-17
 - Going back to our last PGDG, what’s at stake in sharing Jesus?
 - How are people “saved/rescued” for eternity?
 - From the Rom. 6:23 cards, what are people “saved” from?
- Read 1 Cor. 3:5-8. How does our voice and our courage work together to *Duplicate*? What is our responsibility? What is God’s?
- Read Mark 8:31-38. What was wrong with Peter’s perspective?
 - In this passage, list the priorities that Jesus tells his followers to evaluate [if/then]. How do these affect our ability to *Duplicate*?
- What usually holds you back from sharing the message of Jesus?
- Has anything in this series helped you to be more vocal or courageous in sharing Jesus? If so, what are you going to change?
