## **THE SANHEDRIN IN US** Fails to Gee God's Provision

Speedboat vs. Tour Boat

•This Week's Bible Passage & Focus Verse: Acts 7:9-16 Because the patriarchs were jealous of Joseph, they sold him as a slave into Egypt. But God was with him (9, NIV)

## **The Reflection** (required) <u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- •What is the difference between a speedboat and a tour boat?
- Read Genesis 37:3-11, Mark 11:18, & James 4:1-3. What is the root of jealousy? What things make <u>you</u> jealous of others?
  How does jealousy fail to see what God *has* provided?
- In the Point, we looked at three ways that we miss God's provision: *Misled by What Seems <u>Good</u>* (see James 1:16-17; 1 Tim. 6:6-8)
  How does the world define "good"? How do you define "good"?
  How does that affect your view of God's provision?
  - Misinterpret When is the Right <u>Time</u> (see Matt. 6:11; 2 Cor. 9:8)
    <u>When</u> do you typically want things to happen? <u>When</u> does God?
    How does understanding God's timing affect how you view God's provision in <u>your</u> life? How are these things connected?
  - Misunderstand What We <u>Need</u> (see Philippians 4:19; Psalm 23:1)
    What things do you consider to be "needs"? How do you think God feels when we complain that we don't have what we *need*?
- •Share a moment when you were like a speedboat. Share a time when were you like a tour boat. Which was better? Why?
- •What do <u>you</u> need to do to become more like a tour boat?
- •Do you need to confess to God that you were jealous of someone else because you failed to see what He has provided for you?

## The Reinforcement (optional)

Use these questions for further discussion during your group, or at home

- •Review the full story of Joseph in **Genesis 37-50**. List how many different times God continued to provide for Joseph and his family.
- •Read Acts 7:15-16, Gen. 50:26, Ex. 13:19, & Josh. 24:32 for the full saga of Jacob's burial. How many times was his "body" moved? How did this fulfill the promise God made to him in Gen. 28:10-15?
