The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- What can you learn from your last failure? What adjustments do you need to make before you try again?

- What can you do to increase your passion for those without Jesus?
- Do you truly love those who don't know Jesus? Describe things that you or others at mc3 are doing to reach those far from God.
- Is mc3 more outwardly focused or inwardly focused? Be honest.
- If mc3 disappeared, would Mifflin County notice? If not, what can you do to impact MiffCo lives in a more significant way?
- What was the most challenging or inspiring thing for you that Craig said in today's video sessions?
