The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

•*THIS IS NOT A TYPO* As part of *coming back* to *Simply. mc3.,* we're spending September <u>AND October</u> in Pr'me watching and discussing a DVD series called *It* by Craig Groeschel. *It* was a foundational part of the planting of mc3 almost 11 years ago, and includes essentials that were used to guide who we are as a church. It is our prayer that as we chew through these topics, mc3 can honor God and have "it".

- •What can you learn from your last failure? What adjustments do you need to make before you try again?
