# The Repeats (required) They are the same, but WE change, so <u>please</u> <u>discuss</u> these with your group

- [Share the announcements (on FB thread) with your group]

## The Reflection (required) <u>Discuss</u> these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- •When people don't pray, what do you think holds them back?
- •If prayer is simply a conversation with God ...share some ways that people pray that make it <u>not</u> like a conversation. [but be kind!]
- •Before this series, how did you define or describe prayer?
- •Read Matthew 6:10 and Luke 22:42. How does Jesus instruct and demonstrate prayer as *submission*? What does this mean?
- •Read Matthew 6:8,11. We'll look further in week 4, but for now..., how can we balance God's desire to hear our needs vs. submission?
- •Before this series, how did you define or describe confession?
- Read 2 Samuel 12:7-13. What does confession actually mean?
- •Read **Hebrews 4:16**. We are told that we can come boldly to God's throne. What does this mean? Why can we have this boldness?
- •Do you practice confession when you pray? Why or why not?
- •In what ways do <u>your</u> prayers sound more like an Alexa request than a conversation? What do you need to do or think to change that?
- •What meaningful prayer ideas or "methods" have you seen in the Bible or from other godly Christ-followers? Make a list as a group.
- •Which 1 of these above will you attempt this week as you pray?

Use these questions for further discussion during your group, or at home

- •Look up these different prayers in the Bible and answer the following questions for each prayer:
  - •Judges 16:28-30 •Nehemiah 2:4 •Job 3:11-19 •Psalm 51
  - •Jonah 4:1-4 •Habakkuk 1:2-4 •John 17:20-23 •Acts 7:59-60
- •In what ways was each prayer a conversation with God?
- •In what ways was each prayer real, raw, and hones?
- •What can you learn about prayer from each prayer?
