# **RUINED!**

When You're Ruined, Your Confidence Must Go Beyond Your Comprehension

You asked, 'Who is this that questions my wisdom with such ignorance?' It is I—and I was talking about things I knew nothing about, things far too wonderful for me." (v. 1-3, NLT)

# The Reflection (required)Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- •Share the craziest form of transportation that you've ever ridden or wildest trip experience that you've ever had.
- •After God's response about His purposes and His power, Job replies with confidence. Read each statement & verse below, then discuss each question <u>based on all that we've read in Job from *Ruined!*</u>
  - Confidence comes from Trusting –Job 42:1-2
    What do you think led Job to this confidence? Share examples.
  - Humility comes from Amaze-ing –Job 42:3
    How was Job amazed by God? Why did this cause humility?
  - Submission comes from Knowing –Job 42:4-6
    What's the difference between *hearing about* God and *knowing* God?

•Which of these 3 responses by Job is most interesting to you? Why?

- •Like Job, God wants us to trust Him, even if it doesn't make sense. Read & answer <u>for each</u> 1)What was the "make sense"/"usual" way that people handle the situation? 2)What is the *command* here?
  - Where You're Going Proverbs 3:5-6
  - When You're Waiting -2 Peter 3:8-9
  - What You're Earning Matthew 6:31-33
  - Who You're Serving Matthew 5:43-45
  - Why You're Obeying Romans 12:2 (see MSG version)
- Give an example for how <u>each</u> of these could look in our lives today.
- •Which is the hardest for you? Why?
