## The Reflection (required) Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- •Do you have a story of a magnificent bicycle crash when you were younger? Share it with the group.
- •Read and discuss these instructions\* for parents about children:
  - •Raise Them in Jesus Ephesians 6:4b; Deut. 6:6-9; Proverbs 22:6 •As a group, share at least <u>8</u> modern, practical examples for this.
  - Discipline Them in Love Hebrews 12:7-11; Proverbs 23:13-14 •What reasons cause people to tend to shy away from discipline? Why is discipline important?
  - Encourage Them with Patience Colossians 3:21; Ephesians 6:4a
    - •[Before you answer, keep in mind that next week we're going to look at respecting our parents]: How can parents unintentionally discourage their children? How can they encourage them?
  - •Move Them by Faith –Genesis 2:24b; Proverbs 23:22 •What are the 2 extremes of this? Why do you think these happen?
- Parenting is hard. Consider these ways that we can help parents. As you do, share a story (real or invented) of how we could do each:
  - Encourage Their Example Proverbs 20:7 How can we do this?
  - Respect Their Role Matthew 15:3-7 How can we do this?
  - Tell The Truth Ephesians 4:14-16 How can we do this?
  - Enter Their Emotions -1 Cor. 12:24b-27 How can we do this?
- •Parents: which of the above is most important/helpful to you? Why?
- •Everyone: which above are you best at doing? Which needs work?
