MC3SITY IS DIFFERENTLY: WE RISK TO REACH.

The Repeats (required)

They are the same, but *WE* change, so please discuss these with your group

- [Share the announcements (on FB thread) with your group]
- As we did last week, we're going to *open* by sharing God Moments about what He is doing in our lives, but save our prayer requests for the END of Pr'me. Go around and share your God Moments: how have you seen God working, either in your life or in the life of another over the past week? [Leaders: plan for a way to collect prayer requests at the end, then share them with your Pr'me]
- Is there anything that you want to share that has stood out to you so far from the current Point series?

The Reminder (required)

Read this section briefly to review the Point for everyone

- This Week's Point:
mc3sity is differently: we risk to reach.
- This Week's Object Lesson:
stage *behind* the congregation
- This Week's Bible Passage & Focus Verse: 1 Corinthians 9:19-23
I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. (v. 22b, NIV)

The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- Ask those in the *WX* on Sunday to share something different that they noticed or felt by facing the back of the garage for the Point.
- When have you taken a risk and *failed*?
- When have you taken a risk and *succeeded*?
- Set up this week's discussion by having someone read **1 Corinthians 9:19-23**. This passage teaches that Paul was willing to change to reach different people.
- In your opinion, how much change is "allowed"? Where is the line?
- Do *you* like change? Where do you land on the "change spectrum"?
- In what ways can our inability to change negatively affect our message of Jesus to others? Give examples.
- In the Point, Sean said, "the people we might call 'bad', Paul might call 'weak'" (v. 22a). Where does that land with you?
- To do things differently it's going to require being...different! In the Point, we learned that it will mean *Reaching the Unreached* (Rom. 15:20-21), *Serving the "Undeserved"* (Jn. 4:1-7a), and *Using the Unusual* (Acts 17:16-23). Give one example for how each could look at mc3.
- Are any of these ideas new to you? If so, how?
- Which of these three areas are you good at doing?
- In which of these three areas do you need to stretch yourself/risk?
- Paul realized that giving ALL would only reach SOME (1 Cor. 9:22b). Who risked to reach *you* for Jesus? Are you glad they did?
- How far are *you* willing to go to reach others? What does that look like?
- If you feel comfortable, share the name of one person in your life that our Pr'me can be praying for you to reach for Jesus.
