## The Repeats (required)

## The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

Was there a task or goal in your life where you were "laser-focused" on completing it? How did you make sure that you accomplished it?
What parts of your life were affected when you make those changes?

In 1 Cor. 10:31, Paul says that <u>everything</u> that we do should be for one purpose—glorifying God. What does it mean to glorify God?
Paul writes, "whatever you do", but that's usually not the case: To what situations/ways do people tend to *limit* "glorifying God"?

•Where in *your life* have *you* made it "off limits" for glorifying God?

•What do you need to *change* to "open up" this area(action/attitude/etc)?

In 1 Cor. 10:32-33, Paul says that we should do whatever it takes to Point people to Jesus, including "not causing them to stumble".
How can someone's actions/attitudes cause someone to stumble?
Have you seen this happen in your life or in another's life? How?
What could have been changed to keep this from happening?

Some things we do to glorify God are *Watch Your Words* (Col. 3:16-17), *Do What's Right* (Col. 3:22-25), and *Give Your Best* (Mal. 1:7-13).
What would you do differently if you were serving Jesus *in person*?

•When we speak to or serve others, we're told that it's like we are serving or speaking *to Jesus*. How does this make you feel?

•If this is true, what is keeping you from making that change now?

- If we're to do <u>everything</u> to glorify God, then the integrity & quality of our work matters. In your opinion, do Christ-followers or churches have a good or bad reputation in this area? Why or why not?
- •What are ways that we can help to change that reputation?
- If "It's All for Jesus!" does your work reflect integrity & quality for Him?

•What is one "mundane" (i.e., "not churchy") area in your life, that you can focus on this month so you are glorifying God in that area?

•What will you need to do?
