WHEN WE ALLOW JEALOUSY IN OUR LIVES, IT ROTS OUR ABILITY TO FIND CONTENTMENT

The Repeats (required) They are the same, but WE change, so <u>please</u> <u>discuss</u> these with your group

- [Share the announcements (on FB thread) with your group]
- We're going to open by sharing God Moments about what He is doing in our lives, but save our prayer requests for the END of Pr'me.

The Reminder (required) Read this section briefly to review the Point for everyone

•This Week's Point:

When We Allow Jealousy in Our Lives, It Rots Our Ability to Find Contentment

- •This Week's Object Lesson:

 lawn care ("the grass is greener on the other side")
- •This Week's Bible Passage & Focus Verse: Galatians 5:[19] 20-21

 The result of sin's control in our lives is clear. ... It also includes jealousy ... It wants what others have (v. 20, 21a, NIRV)

The Reflection (required) Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- •So where do you land on the lawn care spectrum? What do <u>you</u> do? [PGA tour plays here] < ____[I mow regularly] ____>[I have a lawn?]
- •Let's do some jealousy brainstorming: what [in]famous examples of jealousy do you know, either from pop culture, movies, books, etc.?
- •We're going to see what jealousy looks like, *and* what it looks like in our lives. For <u>each</u> statement below, discuss the following:
 - •Explain this in your own words (read the verse, if necessary)
 - •What has this looked like in your life in the past ...or now?
 - •How does this category of jealousy "offend" God?
 - Jealousy Misses What God Has Provided (1 Timothy 6:6-16)
 - Jealousy Angers At God Giving Others Success (Genesis 4:2-8)
 - Jealousy Ignores How God Created You (1 Corinthians 12:12-18)
 - Jealousy Forgets That God is With You (Hebrews 13:5)
 - Jealousy Focuses On UnGodly Distractions (Php. 4:8; Matt. 6:19-20)
 - Jealousy Denies That God Strengthens You (Philippians 4:11-13)
- Read Galatians 5:24-25. To deal with rotten sin in our lives we:
 - Admit It: From the jealousy categories above, choose <u>one</u> that you need to change. What does that look like in your life, specifically?
 - Kill It: This isn't simply passive—you need to kill jealousy by <u>finding</u> contentment where you are. How can you <u>find</u> contentment in the situation you shared above (under *Admit It*)?
 - •Leave It: Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-5. Giving steers us away from jealousy because if "forces" us to follow the Holy Spirit's leading, and allow Him to provide for us. What is a practical way that this should look like in your life? (Is there a specific need? Do you need to give in the offering? Is there something that you're holding on to that God is leading you to give away?)
