- [Share the announcements (on FB thread) with your group]

## The Reflection (required)Discussthese to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- •What team or brand is your "go-to" for announcing your loyalty (in other words, what team or brand do you own most or wear most)?
- This week's Point was about baptism. Reflect on Sunday and share:
  What is one thing you knew about baptism that was confirmed?
  What is one *new* thing that you learned about baptism?
- •God designed baptism as the way for the church to publically identify Christ-followers. We're going to use a passage as a case-study to go deeper into the "rules" for baptism we learned in the Point. Have <u>EVERYONE</u> open Acts 16:16-34 in the <u>NLT</u> version.
  - •Have someone read Acts 16:16-24 for the set-up to the story.
  - •Ask someone else to read Acts 16:25-28 to continue the story.
  - •Read v. 29-30. What do you think led to the jailer's question here?
  - •How did they answer in v. 31-32? What was the first "step" for the jailer and his household? [believe in Jesus]
  - •According to the second part of v. 33, what happened *next*? [they were baptized immediately] Did they have to attend a class first? [no] Did they have to learn "enough" or know more about the Bible first? [no] Was there an age requirement? [no]
  - <u>Why</u> did Paul & Silas baptize the jailer and his family?
  - •Read v. 34. To clarify: did the *jailer's* belief "save" his household for them? [no] Why not? [because they <u>all</u> *believed*]
- While honoring what God has established, baptism isn't a normal part of our culture outside of church. To help us all gain a better understanding, let's brainstorm a list of some modern examples of how people publically identify themselves as a "part" of something?
  If you are a Christ-follower, have you been baptized as a believer?
  - •If so, please share your story of why/when you were baptized.
  - •If not, what is holding you back? What hesitations do you have?
