GROWING CLOSER IN UNITY Requires Humility

The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- For something completely different: get 2 full rolls of toilet paper, and divide into 2 teams. Have teams race to see which can use a whole roll to wrap up one person from their team before the other team.
- •Discuss: how would the "coverage" be different if you used only a quarter roll of toilet paper (i.e., only a few sheets remaining)?
- •Read 1 Peter 5b. Peter tells us to clothe or wrap ourselves in humility. Using the toilet paper roll as an analogy, what is the difference between using a full roll and a partial roll when it comes to humility?
- •Why do people tend to use a "partial roll" of humility in their lives?
- •Clothing ourselves in humility is going to require us to *be intentional* [wk. 1] in how we interact with those <u>within our relationships</u>. (1)Read the statements <u>and verses</u> below (2)Explain in your own words <u>how each statement ties to the verse</u> (3)Discuss the question below each.
 - Be Sensitive -1 Corinthians 10:11-12
 - •Based on verse 12, how can this <u>in</u>sensitivity *divide* relationships?
 - Be Reflective Matthew 7:3-5
 - •Does this passage mean that we have to be perfect? Why/not?
 - •Be Honest –James 5:15
 - What relational benefits come from confession & vulnerability?
 - Be Responsible Matthew 5:23-24
 - •Do you think most people do this? Why/not?
 - Be Submissive Romans 12:3
 - Teasing next week... why is this important if someone confronts <u>us</u>?
- •Which of the above have you seen others do in their relationships with you, that helped you grow closer to them? [no names necessary]
- •Which one of the above are you better at than the others? Why?
- •Which one of the above needs more work from you? Why?
- •What is <u>one</u> practical thing that you would like to <u>do</u> to work on growing in that area?
