The Repeats (required)

- Welcome to a new cycle of Pr'me Groups! Share your God Moments: how have you seen God working, either in your life or in the life of another over the past month? [Leaders: plan for a way to collect prayer requests at the end, then share them with your Pr'me]
- Throughout last week, we read Revelation 3:15-16. How did that passage affect your life this week?

The Reminder (required)

<u>Read</u> this section <u>briefly</u> to review the Point <u>for everyone</u>

- This Week's Point:
 Someone On Fire Doesn't Just "Read" The Bible; They Delight In It!
- This Week's Object Lesson:
 Sean delighting in old cards from Kendra and his kids
- This Week's Bible Passage & Focus Verse: Psalm 1:1-6
 Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night. (v. 1-2, NIV)
 - Choose someone to rap (yes-rap!) only the <u>first two verses</u> of Psalm One. Choose someone else to beat-box for the rapper.

The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- Who is your most meaningful card/letter from?
- Be honest have you ever delighted in the Bible?

Sean asked four questions to tell if we are On Fire for the Bible:

- Do We Crave It ...or is just a burden? Read 1 Peter 2:2-3. Newborn babies are desperate for milk (repeatedly!). What do you desperately crave (be honest)? What's standing in the way of you feeling that same longing for God's Word?
- Do We Memorize It ...or do we just check it off? Read Psalm 119:11.

 Do you take the time to regularly memorize Scripture? Have you ever? Share a time when you relied on Scripture that you knew in a difficult situation. What are some practical steps you can take to memorize a verse?
- Do We Allow It ...to guide our decisions? Read Psalm 119:105. Do you consult Scripture when you're making important decisions? Share a time when you allowed it to guide you. Did it guide you towards or away from your original inclination in that situation?
- Do We Obey It ...or do we "justify" it? Read James 1:22-25. Are there regular habits or guardrails that you have instituted in your life as a result of what you've learned in Scripture? In what way have you seen God's blessing in your life as a result of your obedience?
- MEDITATION! Read Psalm 119:105 throughout the week. Come prepared next time to share how this verse affected your life this week.
- Leaders, include the following in your prayer time: "Dear God, thank you for your Word. Thank you that it's true and that we can trust it. Thank you that it gives us a glimpse of who you are and how much you love us. Help us crave spending time in your Word more than we crave anything else. And let it change us to be more like Jesus. Amen."
