The Repeats (required)

- This Week's Bible Passage & Focus Verse: Philippians 1:4-6
 I always thank my God as I remember you in my prayers, because I hear about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints. I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ. (NIV84)
 - Read the above passage by going around the group, with each person saying one word at a time.

The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, and more personal, into applying the Point

- Is there any prayer from your childhood that you now find funny or strange?
- Think of a time when you were excited about your faith. Were you actively sharing it with others?

In the video, Craig shared four simple ways to share our faith:

- First Loving, But Direct. Read Acts 2:38-41. Peter was bold what keeps you from sharing your faith more boldly than you already do? What can you do to overcome this obstacle?
- Second Sharing Your Story. When Jesus healed a man who was blind, the Jewish leaders pestered him with questions about who Jesus was. Read his response in John 9:25. Take turns sharing a part of your unique story that could lead someone to follow Jesus.
- Third Invite People to Church. When the Samaritan woman at the well encountered Jesus, she was in awe of him. Read John 4:28-30. Did you first go to church because someone invited you? When was the last time that you invited someone to church? What keeps you from inviting everyone you know who doesn't already go to church?
- Fourth Live a Life That Other People Will Want. Paul and Silas were severely beaten and thrown in jail for healing a demon possessed girl. Read their response in Acts 16:25-32. Does the way you live your life attract other people to Jesus? What changes do you need to make to be more "attractive"?
- MEDITATION! Read Philemon 1:6 (NIV84--see previous page) throughout the week. Come prepared next time to share how this verse affected your life this week.
- Leaders, include the following in your prayer time: "Dear God, please let your love and power become so real to us that we have to share You with others. Give us wisdom and boldness when the opportunities arise. And help us to live lives that reflect you well. Amen."
