The Repeats (required)

They are the same, but WE change, so please discuss these with your group

- [Share the announcements (on FB thread) with your group]
- Share your God Moments: how have you seen God working, either in your life or in the life of another over the past week?
- Throughout last week, we read Matthew 6:21. How has this verse affected your life this week?

The Reminder (required)

Read this section briefly to review the Point for everyone

- This Week's Point:
**Someone On Fire Doesn't Just "Sing Songs";
They *Pour Out* Their Heart!**
- This Week's Object Lesson:
Amazon Reviews vs. a Funeral Eulogy
- This Week's Bible Passage & Focus Verse: **Psalm 42:1-11**
As the deer longs for streams of water, so I long for you, O God. I thirst for God, the living God. When can I go and stand before him?
(v. 1-2, NLT)
- Have each person say the focus verses (Psalm 42:1-2), but substitute their favorite animal for "deer." No duplicates.

The Reflection (required)

Discuss these to go deeper, *and more personal*, into applying the Point

- Come up with a two or three sentence Amazon-style eulogy for yourself.
- Share a time when you experienced worship in a powerful way.

Sean asked four questions to consider whether we are *On Fire* for worship:

- **Do I Worship Unashamedly?** When the ark was coming to Jerusalem, King David danced in worship to the Lord. **Read 2 Samuel 6:20-22.** Have you ever restrained your worship or intensified your worship based on who was around you? Do you find it difficult or uncomfortable to worship freely? What changes can you make to worship unashamedly?
- **Do I Worship Persistently?** Job lost his livestock, his servants, his money, his ten children, and his health. **Read his response in Job 1:20-21.** Have you ever struggled to worship God during a difficult time? On the flip side, have you ever chosen to worship through a very difficult time? If so, how did that impact you? What are some benefits of worshipping through your struggles?
- **Do I Worship Privately (on your own)?** Read Romans 12:1(MSG-The Message). Share some ways that you worship outside of Sunday mornings. How would your relationship with God be different if you worshipped Him with everything you do? How would your relationship with others be different if you worshipped God with everything you do?
- **Do I Worship Selflessly?** Read Matthew 15:1-2, 7-9. There's nothing wrong with having preferences in worship styles. But have you ever allowed your preferences to interfere with worshipping? What can you do to fully worship in the midst of possible "distractions"?
- **MEDITATION! Read Romans 12:1(MSG) throughout the week.** Consider how this verse affects your life this week.
- Leaders, include the following in your prayer time: "Dear God, you are so worthy of our worship. Forgive us for allowing other people, our circumstances, and our preferences to get in the way of our willingness to fully worship you. Help us to worship you freely and fully every day. Amen."

Red Questions: **STOP!** on these and **take time** to have many people discuss
